

As we re-open on the 4th July the safety of our visitors, staff and the local community is our priority. These our measurements in place for Covid-19.

- **Covid-19.** No one should visit the site if they or anyone one in their household has COVID-19 symptoms. See NHS website.
- **Reduced Capacity.** We will be operating at a reduced capacity to limit the amount of people on site.
- **Booking.** You need a booking for a stay at the campsite. We will not [until further notice] operate on a first come first served basis as we have in previous years. There is a minimum booking of 5 nights.
- **Pitches.** Where possible, we will use alternate pitches for the time being.
- **Social Distancing.** We will have floor markings in place in the buildings and have visual reminders for visitors to follow social distancing guidelines.
- **Hygiene.** We will operate a robust, enhanced, cleaning procedure in the communal facilities. We will supply hand sanitizer at the entrance to buildings and plenty of hand soap. We will allow maximum ventilation to the blocks with windows open, entrance doors open. We will supply paper towels for handling hard services and pedal bins to dispose of these.
- **Facilities.** The Communal toilets, showers, washbasins, washing up area will be open with our enhanced cleaning procedure in place. We will have a one way system in the Ladies' wash block. However, in the Mens' wash block we are unable to do this, so we encourage visitors to wear a face covering in this facility and observe the instructions displayed for entering and leaving.
- **Showers** will be open. It will be possible to 'book' a shower slot with a timetable we will have in place
- **The Shop** will be open with a maximum number of visitors allowed. There is a screen in place at the counter and we accept contactless payments to reduce cash handling.
- **Arrival/ Departure.** All visitors will have to confirm their arrival and departure from the site. For departures, it may be possible to do this by phone.

Local Community

- We ask everyone to show consideration, please, for our local community. We urge everyone to respect social distance in all contacts outside the campsite.
- **Please do** consider bringing gloves, face covering, disinfectant, hand sanitiser – just to be on the safe side

Please do not:

- Invite or entertain visitors

The following services will be suspended. You may therefore wish to consider your own arrangements before your visit.

- Ice-block rental facility / use of the freezer for your ice-blocks
- Phone charging facility
- Hairdryer
- Washing machine
