

As we have moved to Step 4 of the Govt Road Map, the safety of our visitors, staff and the local community continues to be our priority. These are our measurements in place.

- Covid-19. No one should visit the site if they or anyone one in their household has COVID-19 symptoms. See NHS website.
- Booking. You need a booking for a stay at the campsite. We will not operate on a first come first served basis as we have in previous years.
- Reduced Capacity. We will be operating at a reduced capacity to limit the amount of people on site.
- Social Distancing. We will have floor markings in place in the buildings for visitors to follow social distancing guidelines.
- Face Covering. We encourage visitors to wear a face covering in the shop and the shared washblock
- Test and Trace. Visitors can check in using the NHS Covid-19 app.
- Hygiene. We will operate a robust, enhanced, cleaning procedure in the communal facilities. We will supply hand sanitizer at the entrance to buildings and plenty of hand soap. We will allow maximum ventilation to the blocks with windows open, entrance doors open.
- Facilities. The Communal toilets, showers, washbasins, washing up area will be open with our enhanced cleaning procedure in place. .
- The Shop will be open, There is a screen in place at the counter and we accept contactless payments to reduce cash handling.
